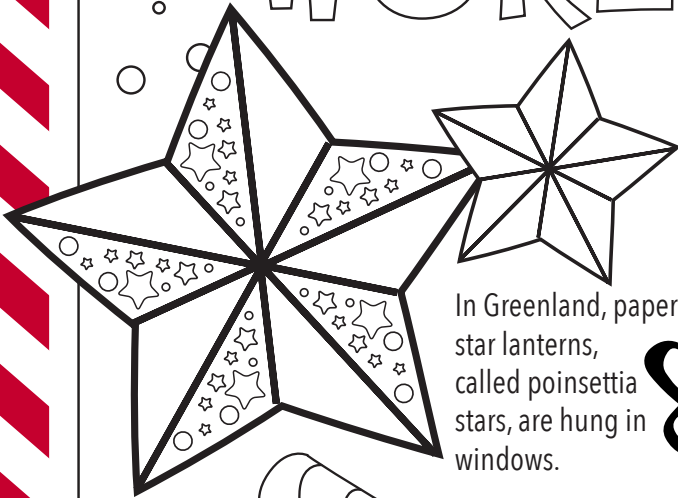


# CHRISTMAS AROUND THE WORLD
